BACKGROUND

The ENO Transportation Foundation (ETF) is a nonprofit organization founded in 1921 by William Phelps Eno. Mr. Eno's primary goal was improving traffic control and safety. Since that time, the ETF's mission has changed and its goal is to improve all transportation modes—ground, water, and air.

For the past 18 years, the ETF has sponsored a Leadership Development Conference. This conference "builds early professional development and leadership qualities among the most promising graduate students considering careers in transportation." The conference offers emerging transportation professionals the opportunity to meet the nation's top policy makers and transportation leaders, and learn about the development and implementation of transportation public policy.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

The 2010 conference will be held **May 17- 20** in Washington, DC.

APPLICATION

WTS members interested in submitting an application for this year's ETF Conference should:

- Include a cover letter with all contact information.
- Be a WTS member in good standing.
- Include a resume—maximum two pages.
- Be pursuing a master's or doctoral degree in a transportation-related discipline or have obtained a master's or doctoral degree (in a transportation-related discipline) within the past five years and be working in the transportation industry.
- Submit a one-page letter of interest. Provide reasons for wanting to participate in this conference and explain how the experience will benefit your professional goals.
- Submit two letters of recommendation, preferably one from a supervisor and one from a professor. If a letter from a professor is not obtainable, submit two letters from senior company management, one being a current supervisor. The letters should detail your qualifications for this program.
- Provide evidence of degree, with date received.
- Provide current grade point average, or, if you have graduated, average at the time of graduation.

The application consists only of the items listed above.

Applications must be submitted no later than Monday, February 22, 2010.

The WTS selection committee will review all applications, and the successful applicant will be notified by phone no later than Friday, March 12, 2010. All other applicants will receive notice by mail.
