2024 WTS-DC Undergraduate Scholarship Application Due October 11, 2024

WTS-DC fosters the development of women in the transportation field by encouraging bright new professionals to undertake careers in transportation. One way it does this is by awarding scholarships in amounts ranging from \$1,000 to \$5,000 to deserving young women who are pursuing undergraduate degrees in a transportation-related field within the Washington, DC area. Recipients at the chapter level also may be nominated for consideration for WTS International scholarships in the amount of \$5,000.

The minimum criteria for selection¹ are:

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Currently enrolled in a degree program in a transportation-related field such as transportation planning or engineering, security planning, business management, finance, logistics, or public policy.
- 2. Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field.
- 3. Attends school in the Washington, DC area.
- 4. Self-identifies as female.

To be considered, you must complete and submit the following items below to the WTS-DC Scholarship and Fundraising Committee at wts.dc.scholarships@gmail.com **before 5:00 p.m. on Friday, October 11, 2024**:

- 1. This typed and signed application form (in electronic format);
- 2. A current resume;
- 3. A current transcript (also include official or unofficial transcripts from schools previously attended in pursuit of your current degree sought);
- 4. A letter of recommendation from a professor or job supervisor;
- 5. Your personal statement, not to exceed 500 words (in Word format);
- 6. Proof of enrollment (such as a copy of your current tuition receipt or registration card); and

¹ Individuals may only apply for a scholarship from a single WTS chapter per year. Female-identifying students who live and/or work in the Washington, DC area and are pursuing online degrees are eligible. Individuals who have previously received scholarships from the WTS-DC Chapter are eligible if they are pursuing a new degree; however, they are not eligible to be selected more than once while pursuing the same degree.

7. (Optional) A letter of recommendation from an additional mentor or advisor you have known in a professional or academic capacity.

The full application must be received by the stated deadline. Applicants are only permitted to apply to one WTS chapter. Recipients will be recognized at the annual WTS-DC Holiday Party in December.
