 obtaining licensure through reciprocity, licensure documentation from the MN Department of Labor &
 Industry must be provided to MnDOT HR prior to starting employment.
- A valid Minnesota Class D Driver's License.
- Ability and skill in the use of hand and power tools sufficient to install, alter, maintain, and repair electrical and electronic systems and equipment in the field.
- Knowledge of State and National Electrical and Safety Codes, construction safety and standard electrical practices, techniques, materials, and tools sufficient to ensure that work and materials comply with codes, and to select supplies, materials, and work methods to apply to electrical projects.
- Ability to manage workload using computerized databases and spreadsheets.
- Human relation skills sufficient to communicate to and effectively work with others including those within MnDOT as well as other governmental agencies and the general public.
- Ability to perform maintenance duties while working at heights up to 70 feet.
