# **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

The WTS organization is dedicated to advancement of women in the transportation industry, and it is required that an applicant pursuing a STEM-related degree demonstrates how she plans to apply her education to contribute to the transportation industry.

#### What is a career in a transportation-related field?

#### Is it okay if the transcript that I submit as a part of my application is an unofficial copy?

No, please submit an official transcript. Your official copy CAN have a watermark.

#### Can I include a resume instead of filling out the entire application?

No, please fill out the information requested as part of the application. Additional information not requested will not be included as part of your application.

If you have not yet filed your FAFSA or have not yet received your SAR, use the Federal Student Aid Estimator at <a href="https://studentaid.gov/aid-estimator/">https://studentaid.gov/aid-estimator/</a> and use the information generated in that report to complete the application.
